Scholarships

Rainbow Energy Center, owner and operator of Coal Creek Station, sponsors a scholarship program for graduating seniors who are pursuing a four-year or vocational-technical degree. This year, up to ten \$500-\$1,000 scholarships will be awarded to graduating seniors.

Eligibility

- Any senior from Garrison, Max, Underwood, Turtle Lake-Mercer, Washburn, Wilton, Center-Stanton, Hazen and Beulah.
- Any senior planning to enroll in a full-time course of study at an accredited college, university or vocational-technical school during the 2026-2027 school year. Funds are to be used for educational costs only.
- Must be a citizen of the United States.
- You do not have to be related to a Rainbow Energy Center employee to receive this scholarship.
